CALL FOR COMMENTS ON GUIDANCE REGARDING THE MEASURES REQUIRED FOR THE MITIGATION OF LOSS OF INTELLIGENCE DATA DUE TO REPORTING FAILURES

**(Wednesday, 18 November 2020):** The Financial Intelligence Centre (the Centre) is calling for comments from accountable and reporting institutions, supervisory bodies and other persons on the <u>draft public compliance communication 111 (draft PCC 111).</u>

The draft PCC 111 provides guidance and clarity on the measures a reporter must take to mitigate the loss of intelligence data in terms of Directive 3 of 2014, the remediation of reporting errors and the prevention of reporting failures.

Comments on the draft PCC 111 should reach the Centre by no later than **Friday**, **18 December 2020**. Comments must be submitted in writing via the online comments submission link only (here).
